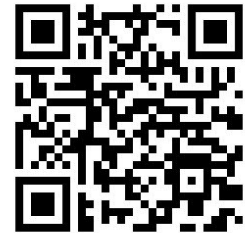

A message from John Dierker—Rector #101

To my fellow Via de Cristo Cursillistas, I have determined that God definitely has a sense of humor. I'm not one to necessarily lead a group of men on a journey through a men's VDC weekend. I prefer to be in the background assisting with whatever is needed to help make a weekend run smoothly so the candidates and the team can have a wonderful 3 days experiencing God up close. So, what does God do? He convinces Kevin Janies and the Secretariat that I am worthy of being a Rector for a men's weekend. I'm asked to be Rector and after much prayer God informs me to take the job. Okay. Fine. I'll do it but God, you need to be there with me. God did stay by my side but just because God is close didn't make the task a piece of cake. I think God thought it wasn't quite the right time, so Covid came along and paused weekend 101 for over 2 years.

A lot of the preparation for a weekend is outlined in a manual that explains the process of setting up a schedule, preparing a team manual, gathering items for the weekend (bells that get stolen, communion elements that may be a bit small, you know, things you see on each weekend) and the most difficult part for me, gathering a group of men to form a team. You see, I have never liked to call people and ask for help. I much prefer to do that in person. That's just me. So now, I need to make many, many phone calls to ask men to join the team. God is still there but I think he gets a little grin when I continue to get shot down by a lot of men. I don't mean this in a bad way. Everyone has busy lives and many of us are just too busy at different times in their lives to fit in 10 weekly meetings, a Saturday walk-thru and 3 days away from work and the family. So...I got a lot of nos. That's what I, a human, thinks. God thinks differently. God knows who should be on the team, I just didn't call the men God wanted on the team. In the end, the team was a group of men like me who love the Lord, love VDC and love bringing other men who love the Lord to VDC to make them stronger Christians.

On every team I've been on, I loved going to the weekly meetings. There's nothing better than a group of men eating great food, singing to the Lord, praying together and just getting to know each other. Each of us have unique talents and abilities that blend together to form a unique men's team that will absolutely do their very best to serve the candidates on the weekend in such a way that the candidates feel like God is at their table. And God is at their tables, smiling away, knowing that his kingdom is becoming stronger because we give the candidates a path to being much, much closer to God. That's what we do as a VDC community. In the blink of an eye, the weekend began. There's that unique VDC excitement in the air. Hands clapping, candidate with that 'deer in the headlights' look and a room full of Cursillistas just having a great time. So, in the Sanctuary, it's noisy and full of energy. When we get up to the Rollo room, silence. You could hear a pin drop. Thursday night is a quiet start to a weekend full of surprises, laughing, crying, bad jokes, great singing, wonderful worship and awesome Rollos.

As a Rector, on the weekend, I'm in my own little world. I get to experience the weekend along with the candidates. I marvel at the change that happens at each table as God lays his hands on the men to mold them into a unique, close group of believers. Each table is different because God guided Ed Dolan and myself in placing the candidates with the right table professors and chas. God has humor. I had one table that were all electricians. But God was also very inciteful. I had one table where each of the men has lost a child. God works in beautiful ways!

After Thursday night's quiet library noise level, the energy picks up throughout the weekend. The candidates get to hear some touching Rollos that shows them that everyone has difficulties in life but with God's help they can persevere through those difficulties to become leaders in their homes, churches and community.

As Rector, I really have a small part in the weekend, it's the rest of the team that makes it happen. The toughest thing I had to do was get close enough to the microphone so that everyone could hear me. I prefer not to 'swallow' the mike. I guess I should have borrowed Ed Dolan's voice when addressing the room, then I wouldn't need a mike. Every man on the team did their very best to show God's light to the candidates through their smiles, actions, and words of encouragement.

Saturday evening was a glorious celebration for the candidates and the team. A beautifully decorated table awaited us with a wonderful dinner lovingly prepared by the kitchen crew and a lot of caring VDC Cursillistas.
