  - 🌈 Pray in the Palanca Chapel, help in the kitchen, serve meals, be at Serenade etc.
- 🌈 Be at closing on Sunday and prepared to take your Candidate home.
- 🌈 PRAY for your Candidate BEFORE, DURING and AFTER the weekend.

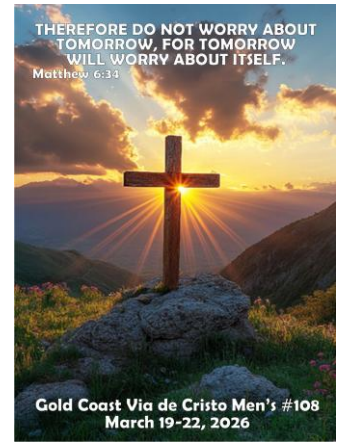
